PRINCIPAL POINTS OF THE AGREEMENT WITH THE REPUBLIC OF BOLIVIA RELATED TO MIGRATION REGULATION

- 1. The date of signature of the agreement between Brazil and Bolivia: 15/08/2005;
- 2. Enforcement in both countries: 15/09/2005
- 3. Objective: To regulate the migratory situation of citizens of both countries, and respective families, who have entered the territory of the other country before and until 15/08/2005 and who have remained in an irregular situation;
- 4. Deadline to apply for regulation: 180 days after the signature of the agreement (15/02/2006)
- 5. Where to apply: Federal Police stations.
- 6. Process: With the protocol of application for regulation, the foreigner will be in a regular situation until the final analysis of the case by the Ministry of Justice;
- 7. Requirements: Passport or Identity Card, Criminal record, declaration that the applicant is not under criminal investigation or has been convicted, proof of means of subsistence, proof of entry into country until 15/08/2005, proof of tax payments (the applicant has 90 days to pay the fine for irregular permanency, two colored photographs.
- 8. Accepted documentation: Can prove entry into territory: stamp in passport, exit/entry card, proof of rental payment, electricity, water, telephone or tuition; receipt or equivalent of purchase of goods or real estate; proof of medication or vaccination card, any other document which may prove the permanency.
- 9. Rights: The immigrants regularized under the contents of this Agreement will enjoy the same rights and be subjected to the same obligations in relation to labor laws that apply to workers of the receptor State, and will enjoy the same protection in what refers to the application of laws relating to hygiene and security at work.
