Work Permit for Foreigners

Normative Resolution Nr. 27 of November 25, 1998

Regulates the evaluation by the National Immigration Council of special situations and omitted cases

THE NATIONAL IMMIGRATION COUNCIL, instituted by Law Nr. 8.490 of November 19, 1992, in the use of the powers conferred by Decree Nr. 840, of June 22, 1993, decides:

- Art. 1 Special situations and omitted cases will be submitted to the National Immigration Council on an individual basis and analysis.
- § 1 Special situations are those that, even though not completely defined in the Resolutions of the National Immigration Council, possess elements that are, considered satisfactory for obtaining a visa or permanency.
- § 2 Hypotheses, which have not been foreseen by the National Immigration Council, are considered omitted cases.
- Art. 2 For the evaluation of requests based on the present Normative Resolution, the criteria, principles and objectives of the immigration will be, followed, according to the pertinent legislation.
- Art. 3 The decisions based on the present Normative Resolution will not constitute passive precedents which may be invoked or form common law for a decision by any other organ.
- Art. 4 Resolution Nr. 32 of October 19, 1994 is hereby revoked.
- Art. 5 This normative Resolution enters into effect on the date of its publication.
